

Driving directions to the store from Kentucky:

With much of our service business in Kentucky, we usually cross the bridges twice daily. Most of the time it is trouble free and the drive to the store only takes 5 or 10 minutes longer than when the Sherman Minton Bridge was open.

From east Louisville:

- > Take I-71 south to I-65 north via the Kennedy Bridge.
- > Stay on I-65 about 6 miles to I-265 west (New Albany exit 6B).
- > Continue on I-265 west approximately 5 miles; merge onto I-64 west.
- > Go about 2 miles to exit 118 (Georgetown). Turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp.
- > Go 4 miles and we are on the left. Look for 2 black lions out front.

The shortest distance and the most reliably trouble free drive seems to be coming through New Albany via the 2nd Street Bridge.

For this route:

- > Take 64 west to the 3rd Street exit in downtown Louisville.
- > Continue down 3rd Street 2 blocks.
- > Turn left onto Market St. then left on 2nd Street.
 - > Continue across the 2nd Street Bridge (US 31 north).
- > Stay on US 31 north (which runs beside I-65 north) until you merge right onto Brown Station Way (US 62 west to New Albany).
- > Stay on Brown Station Way which turns into Spring St. through New Albany to I-64 west.
- > Take I-64 west about 4 miles to exit 118 (Georgetown). Turn right at the bottom of the exit ramp.
- > Go 4 miles and we are on the left. 2 black lions out front.
